A. LA DIENSTSTELLE MÜHLMANN en F R A N C E .

Interrogatoire de Joseph Mühlmann à Uttendorf, près de Zell-am-See; Autriche.

Ce service était fondé en 1941 par l'ordre du Reichskommissar de la Hollande, c.a.d. Seyss-Inquart. Le directeur pour la France était Joseph Mühlmann. Le siège du D.M. se trouvait à La Haye et dépendait du Reichskommissar pour la justice. Le chef était Kajetan Mühlmann; son fondé de pouvoir Eduard Plietzsch; le chef de bureau Joseph Ernst. A eux J.Mühlmann devait remettre ses comptes et factures. L'argent venait d'abord par paquets de Reichskreditkassenscheine qui étaient alors changé en francs français. Plus tard l'argent pouvait être directement levé sur une banque.

Joseph Mühlmann a été aidé par Mad. Jarentchenko, (Mad. Niccle), comme secrétaire, elle se trouve du reste avec lui à Uttendorf. Comme principal intermédiaire on peut nommer l'antiquaire Lagrand de Bruxelles, habitant depuis 20 ans à Paris. Il a réellement conduit Mühlmann partout, il a organisé une exposition chez Charpentier avec Mühlmann, exposition qui a été achetée en bloc par Göring. Lagrand est un personnage très dangereux et peu sympathique, il a du gagner un argent énorme, quand on pense que sa femme réclame Frs.25.000.000.- pour divorcer.

Lagrand a vendu comme prospecteur, comme intermédiaire des autres Belges et Français; il a profité des transports allemands, car le 13 février 1941 quand une tapisserie allait à La Haye, une grande quantité d'objets fut déchargé à l'office des propriétaires rue Wiertz à Bruxelles, et à la place de ces objets d'autres de provenance Belge furent chargés.

Joseph Mühlmann était Hauptmann SS en Pologne, mais demis de ce digne grade quand il a meublé une petite amie avec des objets destinés au Grand Reich.

Il ne s'est pas montré dangereux et s'est surtout distingué par le tas d'objets presque invendables, qu'il a acheté en France. Il habite haut dans la montagne à une heure et demie de tout contact civilisé. (Haus Seimleim- Uttendorf-Zell am See).

Sa secrétaire a été dans la résistance. J'ai pris des renseignements à Paris et effectivement elle a donné des notes intéressantes aux Alliés. Elle est avec lui dans son exil.

SS Gruppenführer Fegelein, the so-called "Reitergeneral der SS", married the sister of Eva Braun in the spring of 1944. The "American Vial", Seewalchen, Itzlberg 25, was to be furnished for them. Since the summer of 1943 Muhlmann lived in the neighbouring house. Fehelein, who knew Muhlmann from Poland, asked him to procure on loan some furniture from the inventory of the Dienststelle Muhlmann. As the house was not yet ready, things were to be sent to Fischhorn, which was the standing-place of the "SS Reiterei". In March Muhlmann sent to Fischhorn:
